**** Under Tasmanian Law, while travelling in a car including an Uber, children under the age of 7 are required to use a booster seat when travelling and children under the age of 4 are required to use a forward facing child restraint, unless the child has outgrown either of these options. When traveling in a bus or Taxi children are exempt from child restraint laws, however must wear a seat belt if seat belts are present ****

Hazards Identified are:

- Children being on unregistered premises
- Access to traffic – i.e. crossing roads
- Challenging play equipment (different parks) and sports activities
- Activities in open areas
- Water
- For a complete overview please see the risk assessment for each excursion

Management of identified hazards will include:

- Minimum ratio of one adult to ten children on excursions
- Minimum ratio of one adult to five children on swimming excursions
- A person who holds a bronze medallion will be available at every swimming outing

Hazards will vary depending on the excursion planned on the day. The activities that are available on each excursion vary and the purposes of all excursions are to provide children with recreational and educational experiences.
